PROJECT TASI MANE



A project that emphasizes a key component to strengthen TIMOR GAP portfolio as the country's oil and gas company, with three industrial clusters envisioned in the Tasi Mane Project, along with construction and upgrade of supporting infrastructure encompassed. To achieve this reality, we continuously push forward on the implementation, setting targets within timeline.

On early February, 74% physical progress has been registered on the Suai Airport, the main features will include a 1.5 km long runway, a new terminal building, accommodating also customs and immigration, a fire station and a helipad with Medivac air ambulance facilities. The inauguration of the Suai Airport is projected to be on June 2017.

Significant progress has been achieved for section I of the Highway (30.4 km), connecting Suai to Fatukai/Mola, with Section I divided in four branches and construction and these includes embankment, drainage excavation, pipe laying and bridge building. Manpower for this project totals 1200 workers, with both locals and foreign workers accounting to 79.7% and 20.3% respectively
